

OSHA 30hr General Industry

OVERVIEW:

The OSHA 30-hour General Industry Course will train and educate employers and employees in recognising, rectifying, preventing and avoiding unsafe and unhealthful working conditions. This programme will improve the skill and knowledge levels of personnel engaged in work related to the Occupational Safety and Health Act of Trinidad and Tobago (2004) (OSH).

This comprehensive training will provide participants with the knowledge needed to apply OSHA (USA) safety & health standards, policies and procedures to their organisation's on-going safety & health program.

Students will be introduced to OSHA policies, procedures and standards as well as general industry safety and health principles of both the TT OSH Act and the US OSHA Act.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon successful completion of this course participants will be able to:

- State the elements of a Record Keeping system
- Identify and develop a Hazardous/toxic materials programme
- Describe the key elements of Safety & Health programs
- Identify the elements of Emergency Action Plans
- Recognise common Electrical hazards
- Identify Ergonomic hazards
- Define the requirements of Walking/Working Surfaces
- Describe the requirement for Egress & Fire protection
- Define the requirements of a Hearing Conservation plan
- Describe the different types of Personal Protective Equipment
- Recommend procedures for dealing with Blood borne Pathogens
- Recognise and describe hazards of Confined Spaces

- Perform a Job Safety Analysis
- Perform a Hazard Identification of the job site
- Develop and apply a Lock-out/tag-out programme
- Conduct an Accident Investigation
- Conduct a Machine Guarding programme

TARGET GROUPS:

The OSHA 30-Hour General Industry course is a comprehensive safety program designed for anyone involved in general industry, including:

- Owners
- Supervisors
- Human Resources
- Safety Managers – normally non-construction.

CERTIFICATION:

Candidates who successfully complete the OSHA-30 Hour General Industry exam will receive an OSHA 30-Hour General Industry card from the U.S. Department of Labour within 4-6 weeks of examinations.

They will also receive a Certificate of Participation from the Arthur Lok Jack Graduate School of Business – University of the West Indies.
