

PROJECT RISK MANAGEMENT

December 8th - 10th, 2009

Overview:

Risk management has become increasingly more visible as an integrated component of an effective project management plan. In this course, students learn to identify, analyze, and mitigate project risks. The course also explores risk response control and the development of lessons learned with the purpose of developing an organizational history for future projects. Through the use of lectures, exercises, a case study, and classroom discussion, students gain both practical knowledge that can be applied to current projects and basic knowledge that will aid in preparation for the PMP® certification examination.

Desired Outcomes:

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Conduct an effective risk identification workshop for their projects
- Prepare a thorough analysis of the financial, technical, and budgetary implications of their risks
- Develop risk mitigation approaches that improve the potential for success of their project
- Implement effective risk response control methods to ensure that they stay ahead of any potential risk events
- Build a higher level of team commitment to the implementation of the projects risk plan

Target Groups:

- Project Managers, Project Coordinators, Accounting and Finance Professionals who undertake financial planning for projects, Professionals working in a “projectized” organization who support or provide resources for large projects
